The Division of Local Aid announces the next training session for the Department's end-to-end online Project Management Solution: PMRS!

PMRS provides a platform for online collaboration between Local Public Agencies (LPAs) and NJDOT staff. It enables efficient project management, including automated tasks, an electronic document routing and management system, electronic review and approval, easy project tracking, and monitoring. The new platform will make it easier for everyone involved to track, monitor, and know the status of submissions and projects at every step of the way.

This Project Management & Reporting System (PMRS) training session will cover the Local Aid Project Management Process (LAMP) which includes: PS&E submission, Bidding, Invoicing (LAINV), Construction Kick Off (LACKO), Material Questionnaire & Asphalt Waiver (LAMQ), and Change Orders (LACO).
